

# Miyajima Route Map for a One Day Stay

## Recommended route for a one day stay

- Miyajima Pier
- ↓ 3 minutes
- Omotesando shopping arcade
- ↓ 3 minutes
- Mikasanohama → Otorii → Itsukushima Shrine → Daiganji Temple
- ↓ Takinokoji path 5 minutes
- Daishoin Temple (about 50 minutes)
- ↓ Momiji Path 6 minutes
- Shinomiya Shrine → Momijidani Park
- ↓ Ropeway - about 20 minutes
- Mount Misen summit (about 90 minutes)
- ↓ Ropeway - about 20 minutes + 10 minutes
- 5-story Pagoda and Toyokuni Shrine (Senjokaku)
- ↓ Machiya-dori 10 minutes
- Miyajima Culture and Industry Hall → Miyajima Pier



Ropeway: A unique experience of traveling up the mountain via ropeway while overlooking the Seto Inland Sea

One of the best places in Japan to view the gorgeous fall colors of the changing maple leaves.

It is said that one of your wishes will come true if you pray very hard to the Ichigan Daishi statue behind the Daishin Do hall.

5-Story Pagoda: It is a bright, vermilion Pagoda with a skilful mix of Japanese and Chinese styles. Toyokuni Shrine (Senjokaku). It was administered by Hideyoshi Toyotomi. Named for its vastness, it is also called "Senjokaku," meaning the hall of 1000 tatami mats.

Old main street and old houses remain.

A unique and very beautiful floating shrine with an ambiance that constantly changes with the moving tides of the sea.

An exhibition of traditional shops. It is also the place where visitors can experience hand made Momiji yaki.

There are many shops along this street where you can find Miyajima specialties like eel, and oyster dishes. You can also find many kinds of restaurants and souvenir shops.

Walk to the foot of the Otorii at low tide and experience the magnificent view as you look up at the great red gate.
